THE SCHOOL AND THE COMMUNITY

Crosspoint Christian School is the result of the unification of two private Klamath Basin Christian Schools in 2020. Nestled in the Gatewood neighborhood we serve 350 students (P-K through 12) on a 26-acre campus. The student-teacher ratio is 15:1. Klamath Falls is home to Kingsley Airfield, Oregon Institute of Technology (Oregon's Polytechnic University) and Klamath Community College. The Klamath Basin is an agricultural community in the south-central portion of Oregon, just 60 miles from Crater Lake National Park.

CURRICULUM and GRADING SYSTEM

Biblical integration is threaded throughout the curriculum. Students may choose from a career & technical pathway or college bound pathway. Junior and Senior students have opportunities for dual enrollment with Klamath Community College and 95% of the Class of 2023 enrolled in dual credit courses.
